WHEREAS, the City of Bronte (the "City") recognizes that the amount of water available to its citizens and customers is limited; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to conserve water resources; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to comply with the rules of the Texas Water Development Board should it decide to avail itself of various financial assistance programs found in Titel 31, Texas Administrative Code Chapter 363;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRONTE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find and declare that sufficient and timely written notice of the place and subject matter of this meeting adopting this Resolution was posted. The City Council further ratifies, approves, and confirms such written notice and the posting thereof.

Section 5. The City Mayor or his designee is hereby directed to file a copy of the plan and this Resolution with the Texas Water Development Board in accordance with Title 31, Chapter 363 of the Texas Administrative Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect after passage and publication.
