Local entity ballots set

The filing period for the local government entity elections ended Friday, February 15, 2019, and the ballots are now set for the May 4, 2019, election.

The City of Robert Lee will hold an election for three two-year terms, formerly held by Janie Munoz and Roger Alexander and currently held by Ricky Green. There is also a special election for the one year unexpired term. Ann Hedges was appointed to the seat last fall when Billy Williams resigned his council seat to become the City Superintendent. Filing for the two year terms are Manuel Abalos, Tracy Grantham, Ricky Green, Ann Hedges, David Lewis, Becca McGuire and Jason Moran. Zachary Van Tine filed for the special election.

The City of Bronte has terms for three council positions. These are two year terms. The offices are currently held by David Bedford, Stormy Vaughn and Santiago Rodriguez. Filing for these seats are Stormy Vaughn, Santiago Rodriguez and Ron Cooper.

Bronte ISD will hold an election to elect two members to the Board of Trustees. These are three year terms currently held by Shane Kelton and Josh Schoenfield. Josh Schoenfield, David McWright and T. J. McCullough have filed for these positions.

Robert Lee ISD will also hold an election to elect two members to the Board of Trustees. These are three year terms currently held by Beverly Sinclair and Erin Oleksiuk. Both incumbents have filed to retain their seats on the board.
