Bobbie J. Allen passed from this life to her heavenly home on April 20, 2023.

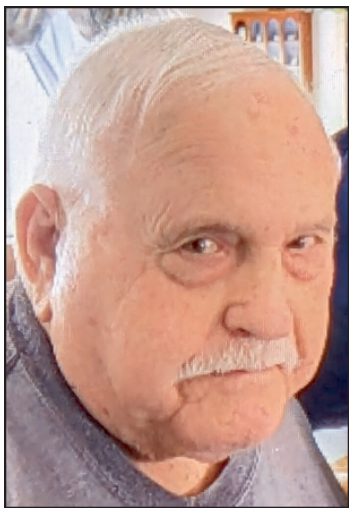

Curbside Clean-up to be held April 29

The City of Robert Lee's spring curbside clean-up will be held on Saturday, April 29. Acceptable items include the following: furniture, appliances, microwaves, dishwashers, metal, scrap iron, twin-full-queen mattresses, washers/dryers, stoves, water heaters; freezers/refrigerators (compressors must be removed); fence wire (must be rolled up, clean, no posts, weeds or grass); push mowers/weed eaters (oil and gas must be drained; tree clippings (must be bundled and under 4 feet in

length.

The following items will not be accepted: household trash, tires, oil, batteries, chemicals, paints, hazardous materials, solvents, commercial construction material, TVs, monitors, printers, computers, laptops, fax machines, and king size mattresses.

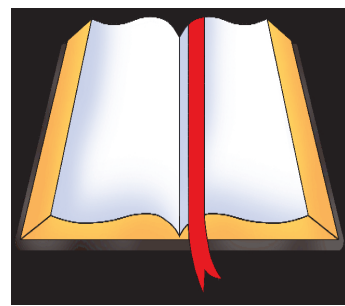

Bronte Depot Preservation Project to participate in San Angelo Gives

The Bronte Depot Preservation Project will be participating in the annual San Angelo Gives event on May 2.

The preservation project is committed to the promotion of the rich railroad history of Coke County and the preservation of the Depot. There are several projects that need to be addressed as soon as possible, such as the roof and structural damage to the building. The Depot was completed in 1911 and there is also a Texas Historical Plaque that was erected in 1989.

The long-term goal is to have the Bronte Depot available to the county and community for meetings and events; a museum highlighting the county, town, and railroad; handicapped restrooms; small kitchen; and a venue space in the back room.

Every donation made during the San Angelo Gives event will make a huge difference in the preservation of the Bronte Depot.
