Starting May 1, 2023 Ending May 31, 2023 Customers Affected: All

In order to conserve the available water supply and/or to protect the integrity of water supply facilities with particular regard to domestic water use, sanitation, and fire protection, and to protect and preserve public health, welfare, and safety and minimize the adverse impacts of a water supply shortage or other water supply emergency conditions, the City of Robert Lee adopted Ordinance 1312, Drought Contingency Plan.

The provisions of this plan shall be applied to all customers utilizing water provided by the City of Robert Lee. The terms "person" and "customer" as used in this plan include individuals, corporations, partnerships, associations, and all other legal entities.

The triggering criteria described below are based on a statistical analysis of the vulnerability of the City of Bronte's water sources and Drought Contingency Plan (DCP) triggering criteria under drought conditions as follows:

Requirements for initiation – The City of Robert Lee will recognize that a MILD water shortage occurs when any one or more of the following conditions exist;

• Average daily water consumption rises to 90% of the production capacity of the water treatment plant for a period of three consecutive dates; or

• The Lake level in Oak Creek drops to an elevation of 1985 feet (msl). Normal lake levels are 2000 feet (msl).

The City of Robert Lee may establish any threshold conditions it deems appropriate in addition to the Drought Contingency Plan and drought response measures initiated by the City of Bronte. Drought Contingency measures outlined in this program, as well as additional measures, can be implemented at any time. In emergency conditions, the Mayor of the city of Robert Lee may enact any conditions that might be appropriate due to unforeseen circumstances. Stage 1 Response - Mild Water Shortage Conditions The goal of MILD Condition drought contingency measures is to achieve a voluntary 10% reduction in daily water demand. • The City will utilize the Local News Media to inform the public that all consumers will be requested to voluntarily

users will be contacted and requested to reduce water use to the greatest extent possible.

• A voluntary outdoor water use schedule will be published. The recommended water use schedule for Robert Lee is as follows;

• Watering should only occur between the hours of 6:00 AM until 12:00 noon and 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City of Robert Lee that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Plan are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Plan shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Plan, since the same would not have been enacted by the City of Robert Lee without the incorporation unto this Plan of any such unconstitutional clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section.

Requirements for Termination – Stage 1 on the Plan may be rescinded when all the conditions listed as triggering events have ceased for a period of 30 consecutive days. The city of Robert Lee will notify all retail and wholesale customers and the media of the termination of Stage 1.
