The Robert Lee Independent School District will hold and Pre-k-Headstart Kindergarten pre-registration on Monday May 2, 2016, from 5:30 to 6:30 in the Elementary School Office. Prospective Pre-k students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2016, to be eligible for the 2016-2017 school year.

Documents needed Headstart will be proof of all family income, proof of age, child's shot record, SNAP (if applicable) and proof of Medicaid, CHIP or Private Health Insurance.

All new students to the Robert Lee ISD Pre-Kindergarten through 6th grade encouraged to attend. Required documentation for enrollment will include Birth Certificate, Social Security Card and current immunization records. Registration packets may also be
