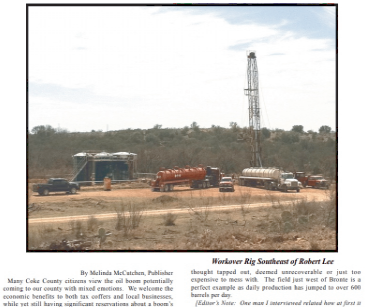

## Joke County Water Supply Corporation awarded grant

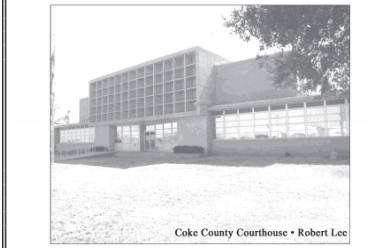
