Dedication! On Monday, May 20, members of the Friends of the Robert Lee Care Center watched as Ricky Ross placed a dedication sign for the gazebo at the Care Center. The sign is placed on a rock that came from the Rosses' pasture. The gazebo project began in 2019 with the formation of a committee to study the construction of a structure to shelter the residents from the sun when they went outside. The notion of a gazebo had been raised years before but construction had not been started. A committee of four auxiliary members, Beverly Bell, Harriett Ann Demere, Beth Prather, and Kip Wallace, began the research into construction materials and cost to complete, as well as ways to fund the project.

A grant was submitted to the San Angelo Area Foundation and it was approved and funded in January 2020. Bids were requested and in March, Felipe Rangel of G&R Construction was awarded the bid. Work was to begin by March 30 but Covid struck the nation and all work was postponed. The road to completion was definitely a rocky one with access to the site being granted and then closed due to Covid restrictions and illness of workers. The work was then completed in July 2021 by Clay Crooks. The residents have been enjoying their new space for quite some time and feedback from the residents and their families has been positive. The next decision came with the size, type, and placement of the dedication sign. Angelo Awards offered the solution and engraved a stainless steel plaque which was placed on a rock and set next to the gazebo. This plaque commemorates all those who have made the gazebo possible. The auxiliary is grateful to all who participated in any way, those who helped with advice, those who contributed through fundraisers, and those who had a hands on part of the completion. The project has provided another space for the residents to enjoy and proven that the community supports one another.
