Jack served in the Air Force from 1951 to 1974 as a

navigator/bombardier and electrical engineer. He was stationed at Okinawa, California, Oklahoma, Ohio, New Mexico, and Maryland. After retiring from the Air Force as a lieutenant colonel, he settled in Maryland and worked in the aerospace industry until 1997.

After this final retirement, Jack enjoyed swimming, bicycling, church activities, and being with his grandchildren. He and Glo also enjoyed traveling, particularly to their second home in Robert Lee where his favorite activities were visiting relatives and bicycling around the scenic roads of Coke County.

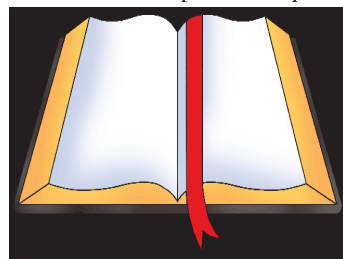
