"Some of it was damaged more than others. There's some milo in the field that hadn't been harvest yet, and it looks pretty

Much of the corn crop, which is ready to be harvested, suffered under Beryl's 70 mile per hour (mph) winds.

"I didn't see anything that was blown over all the way to the ground. All of it just leaned pretty bad, so I think the harvest equipment will still be able to get through once things dry and field conditions get better," he said.

Red noted the cotton is two weeks to a month away from being defoliated.

"The cotton is blown pretty bad, too. You can't really tell which direction the rows are running, it's blown that bad, but it's still standing," he said. "The cotton crops looks like they can

be salvaged, and for the most part, we had a really good cotton crop in the county."

Despite the severe weather, Reed remains hopeful.

"These things happen, and you have no control. When you put that seed in the ground, you may never harvest it, but it's never an easy pill to swallow when that comes along," he

The challenges brought by Bervl are evident.

There's major flooding in his area, with creeks and drainage systems overflowing.

"The winds were up to 90 mph, and we had quite a bit of rain," he said. "I don't know how much rain we got, but I have six-inch gauge that was running over when I emptied it this morning."

Beryl was not as damaging as Hurricane Harvey, but Reed noted he still remembers what that time felt like.

"I still have images of Hurricane Harvey in mind," he said. "It'll probably be there from now on, but this storm was not nearly as damaging as that."

Acting Texas Governor Dan Patrick declared 121 counties to be disaster areas ahead of the storm on Sunday.

# **Drawn Hunt Program** opens applications

Hunters will have new opportunities and scenery this fall through the Texas Parks and

Wildlife Department's (TPWD) drawn hunt permits program.

The program, which issues permits for drawn hunts on both public and private lands throughout Texas, is now accepting applications for a shot at nearly 9,400 permits in more than 60 high-quality categories.

"The opportunities offered through our online Public Hunt Draw System give hunters a tremendous variety to hunt and see Texas at an affordable cost" said Kelly Edmiston, TPWD public hunting coordinator. "Throughout the state, we have seen lack of access to land being a major barrier of entry for folks interested in hunting. The public hunt program gives everyone an opportunity to hunt without the costly investment."

Among the offerings available through the Texas Public Drawn Hunts system: hunts for whitetailed and mule deer, pronghorn, turkey, alligator and dove, plus guided packages for exotic species and bighorn sheep. There were 292,000 applications last

Applicants for e-Postcard hunts and U.S. Forest Service (USFS) Antlerless Deer Permits must have a current Annual Public Hunt Permit (APH) to apply. APH permits go on sale annually on Aug. 15. Last year, the sale of 58,417 APH permits generated approximately \$2.7 million in revenue for wildlife conservation and public hunting opportunities.
