President Beverly Burdett called the meeting to order at 9:45 am, declared a quorum was present, and Chris Martin gave the invocation. Board members present were Betty Lewis, Pat Stephens and Noel Tinkler. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Roger Alexander, Janie Munoz, and Lyza Frasco, with Cross Healthcare Mgmt, were also present at the meeting. There were no visitors.

The administrator gave the staffing update; currently fully staffed. Facility just completed a CNA class and will have another in July.

The census stands at 33 as of the meeting date, with 2 pending, and 4 inquiries.

Accounts Receivable were reviewed.

Financial statements were reviewed and accepted, pending corrections.

The Administrator gave his report, first giving the Board an update on QIPP/QUAPI, which is going extremely well.

The electrical work continues and arrangements are in the process to ship the new generator.

There were no trust deeds needing action.

The work on the upgrades to the Coke Co. Food Pantry is progressing.

The Robert Lee Access Clinic is going extremely well and plans are being made to purchase a portable x-ray machine for use in the Clinic and Care Center.

There will be an upgrade to the a/c system in the front offices of the Care Center.

Future agenda items were discussed and the next meeting will be July 30, 2024, at 9:30 am. The public is invited and encouraged to attend.
