The Texas State Parks Pass, which gives passholders and their guests unlimited free day-use access to all 88 Texas State Parks, is increasing its annual price from \$70 to \$95 on September 1. This is only the second time the price has increased since the program was instituted in 2004. park pass, this is the perfect time to do it!"

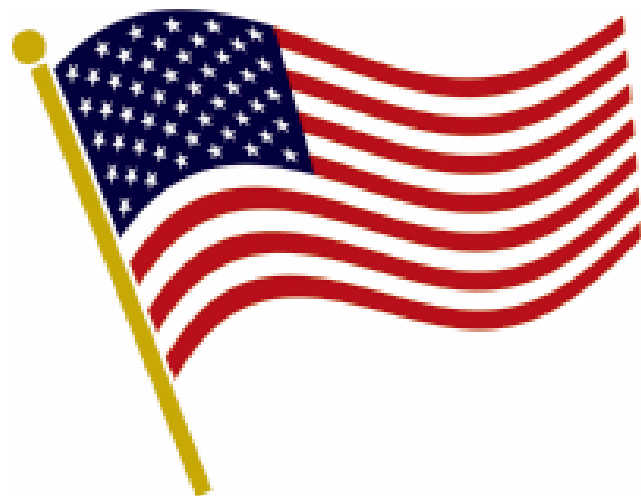
There are special events at parks that happen only during the summer, added Kreindler.
