DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE REQUIREMENTS

(In compliance with P.L. 100-690, Sec. 5153 and 34 C.F.R. 85.630)

BLACKWELL CISD prohibits the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance, as that term is defined in state and federal law, in the workplace or any school-related event.

Employees who violate this prohibition may be referred to drug counseling programs, drug rehabilitation programs, or employee assistance programs or may be terminated from employment with the District.

As a condition of employment in the District, each employee shall abide by the terms of the requirements and prohibitions set out in this statement and shall notify the District of any criminal drug statute conviction for a violation occurring in the workplace no later than five days after such a conviction.

Within 30 days of receiving notice of a conviction for any drug statute violation occurring in the workplace, the District shall either: (1) take appropriate personnel action against the employee, up to and including termination, or (2) require the employee to participate satisfactorily in a drug abuse assistance or rehabilitation program approved for such

purposes by a federal, state, or local health agency, law enforcement, or other appropriate agency.

Surviving family members have few options other than to sell off farm and ranch assets, jeopardizing the viability of their businesses and the future of family farms.

Farmers and ranchers need a permanent fix.

“Families shouldn’t be forced to sell off or split up their farm that has often been in their name for generations,” Kelly said. “To support the next generation of American farmers, we must do everything we can to ensure that family farms aren’t burdened with a sky-high estate tax should a loved one pass away. This bill will go a long way toward helping hardworking folks stay on their land in their time of need and for generations to come.”

Tax laws must protect, not harm, farmers and ranchers, agricultural groups say.

“Texas farm and ranch families often face a significant financial burden when they have to pay estate taxes and should be able to continue operation without having to sell land, livestock or equipment,” said Laramie Adams, Texas Farm Bureau Associate Director of Government Affairs. “Farmers and ranchers should be able to

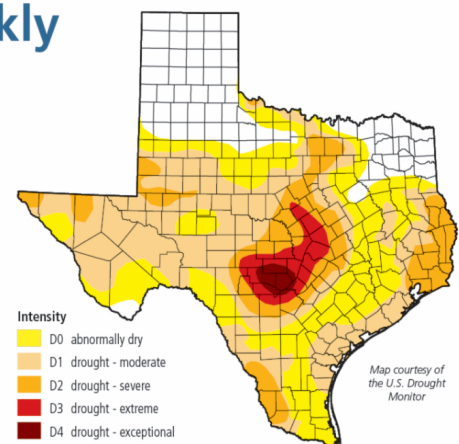

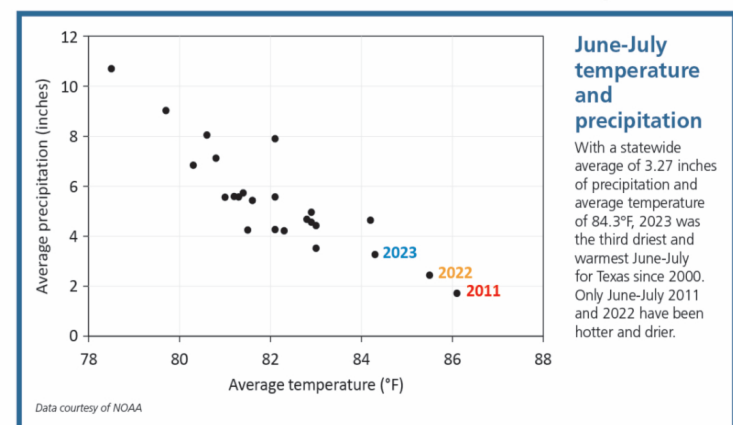
Water conditions
