Last week, I wrote that television and its advertisers created a national culture and erased local culture in their wake. Berry describes it thusly: "as the exposed and disregarded soil departs with the rains, so local knowledge and local memory move away to the cities, or are forgotten under the influence of homogenized entertainment, and education." Somehow, the internet has made that worse. The influence of television ad men has even been overridden by the mysterious algorithms that decide what we should see, watch, and hear on social media. Is there a human at the controls or is it automated? Who can say? And yet, this is what we are fed on our screens every day.

"Luddite" has long been a pejorative term for people who oppose technology, but I have come to realize how they got a bad rap. If you study the Luddite movement of 19th century England, you see clearly that the Luddites did not oppose technology. They warned against technology displacing workers with machines and destroying community and relationships, all in the name of lining the pockets of industrial tycoons. Sounds reasonable, right?
