Appliances, BBQ grills propane (without tank), fluorescent light bulbs, brush/ limbs (cut to less than 4' length and bundled/tied, leaves bagged), furniture, mattresses, box springs, carpeting (small pieces), fiberglass tub/shower, toilets, outdoor items (bicycle, kiddie pools, ladder, large plastic play toys, wheelbarrow, tub cover), hot exercise equipment, TVs, computers, lawn equipment (all fluid removed), wooden pallets,

window frames (no broken glass), white goods/appliances (copper line is cut and made visible).

Unacceptable items include the following:

Household trash, tires, rocks, glass, shingles, roofing material, hazardous material (paint, household cleaners), contaminated soils, metal hangers, propane/fuel tanks, construction/remodeling material (bricks, sheetrock, insulation, flooring).
