CITY OF ROBERT LEE **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Ordinance 23-24 Water Rates & Taps was amended with the second reading being on August 26, 2024. The changes are as follows:

Section 1 Water Rates and Payments

Water rates and charges for the services furnished by the Waterworks System shall be as follows:

Customers inside the city limits shall be charged a minimum charge of \$50.00 with an allowance of 0,000 gallons included in the minimum charge. Water charges shall be split up into tiers as follows:

0 - 12,000 gallons: \$4.75

12,001 – 25,000 gallons: \$5.44 25,001 – 40,000 gallons: \$5.89 40,001 – 55,000 gallons: \$6.58

55,001 – 75,000 gallons: \$7.37 75,001 - 100,000 gallons:

\$8.28

100,001 & greater: \$9.74

Customers outside the city limits receiving water shall be charged a minimum of \$52.50

with an allowance of 0,000 gallons. Water charges shall be split up into tiers as follows:

0 - 12,000 gallons: \$4.75

12,001 – 25,000 gallons: \$5.44 25,001 – 40,000 gallons: \$5.89 40,001 – 55,000 gallons: \$6.58 55,001 – 75,000 gallons: \$7.37

100,000 gallons:

100,001 & greater: \$9.74

Commercial service hookups for large usage customers will be determined by the council and set at a rate of \$5.11 per thousand gallons with minimum charge of \$50.00 with an allowance of 0 gallons with the minimum charge.

Service hookups that fall under the "Golf Course" "Cemetery" classification have a minimum charge of \$0.00 with an allowance of 0 gallons. Any usage shall be charged according to the tiered system

Rates and fees charged to the Coke County Water Supply Corporation and The Snead Corbin Water Supply Contract shall be subjected to the same increase imposed in the City.

If a contract is not in effect with the Coke County Water Supply Corporation, following rates shall be enforced:

\$200 Base Fee

\$1.25 X 188 customers*

*the number of customers to be updated once per quarter at CCWSCs request

\$5.11 per thousand gallons usage rate

A Capital Improvement Fee of \$1.25 shall be charged on each meter for infrastructure.

A Connection Fee of \$20.00 be charged on new

customer accounts, transfer of service, and for turning on/off water at the customer's request during regular business hours.

A service fee of \$25.00 per hour shall be charged to any customer who creates a work order for their personal property outside of the normal duties of the Public Works Department. After hour requests will be charged at \$50.00 per hour.

A customer may request a reread of their meter in case they do not feel the billing is accurate. In this case, a City Employee will get a manual reading of the meter and compare the reading to the electronic reading on file. If there is found to be an error, the City Secretary will cause a correction to be applied to the account. If it is found to be no error, the customer shall be required to pay a service charge

Customers and/or realtors may request to temporarily turn on the water at an address for inspections. These services will require a \$40.00 payment prior to the turn-on date. Inspection services will include three (3) business days of services and will automatically terminate services after the third business

Customers may request a Data log of their meter for any reason with the following fees. Fees are based on a calendar

1st Data Log: FREE 2nd Data Log: \$25.00 3rd Data Log: \$50.00 4th Data Log: \$75.00

5th Data Log: \$100.00

Customers may request for their meter to be tested. In this case, the city will replace the meter with a temporary meter and the pulled meter will be sent off for a certified meter test. In the case the meter reading is high, the city council will determine correction action on the customer bill. In the case that the certified meter test results show the meter to register as accurate or less than accurate, the customer must pay a service meter test of \$125.00.

Utility Bill payments may be made by cash, check, money order, credit/debit card, or bank draft. All returned checks and/or bank drafts will be assessed a handling fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for administrative costs. If a check is returned, payment for the returned check must be made by cash, money order, credit/debit card payment, or bank draft.

After three (3) returned checks and/or bank drafts have been received by the City over a two (2) year period, using the date of the last returned check and/or bank draft, only cash, a cashier's check, a credit/debit card, or money order will be accepted for payment.

Section 2 Water Sales:

Bulk water shall be charged at a rate of \$0.83 per barrel of \$19.68 per thousand gallons. Customers receiving bulk water may be billed monthly and charges shall be due and payable upon receipt of the invoice. The privilege may be suspended at the discretion of the City.
